With a 23 per cent market share, and 35,500 wind turbines installed, Vestas is the world's leading supplier of wind power solutions. Vestas has just begun manufacturing components in the United States in 2008.

Vestas installed its first wind turbine in 1979 and has since played an active role in the fast-moving wind power industry. From being a pioneer in the industry with a staff of approximately 60 in 1987, Vestas today is a global, market-leading group with over 15,000 people employed.

For more than a year, Christopher has been involved in turbine supply contracts and worked on the Central Plains project in Wichita, Kansas, which will be owned by Westar Energy when completed this year.
