Motion to File Comments in CC Docket No. 98-170 and WC Docket No. 04-36 (Federal Communications Commission)

In the Matter of Truth-in-Billing and Billing Format IP Enabled Services.

Background:

On December 13, 2019, the Federal Communications Commission sent out a Public Notice soliciting comments from any interested parties regarding truth-in-billing practices and their applicability to Voice over Internet Protocol (VoIP) providers.

The KCC telecommunications Staff prepared written comments that they would like the Commission to endorse and file. The comments themselves advocate for VoIP providers to be subject to truth-in-billing rules at the federal level. They explain the consumer benefits of charges being made clear on customer bills including helping customers choose amongst different providers and being informed about surcharges and fees. The comments specifically support the identification of governmental fees on bills and whether they are mandatorily imposed by law or simply authorized.

Background:

On January 30, 2020, Southern Star Central Gas Pipeline, Inc. (Southern Star) filed proposed tariff sheets reflecting a rate increase for a Capital Cost Recovery Mechanism (CRM) approved in their last rate case.

Upon review, our D.C. counsel recommended that the KCC file a doc-less intervention to monitor the case and file any substantive comments as might be warranted depending upon Staff's technical review of the information.
